STEWARDSHIP

Stewardship is not a matter of **“how much is it?”** or **“how much is needed?”**. Stewardship and generosity are aspects of spiritual discipline and indications of our spiritual maturity.

In stewardship we acknowledge that all we have is a gift from God and we are to use his gifts in ways that honor him. This transforms our understanding of the blessings in our life. It prompts us to use our blessings for the good of others and for the glory of God.

Just as the walls of Jerusalem were broken through neglect or indifference, a neglected spiritual life can also become dilapidated and broken. The words of Nehemiah call us to renew and rebuild our commitment to our faith, and our dedication and support for our Church and its ministries.
